

National Solemnity of St George : 23rd April

According to legend, Saint George of Lydda was a Christian soldier in the Roman army who was martyred by the emperor Diocletian in the 3rd century for refusing to renounce his faith. He is one of the Fourteen Holy Helpers, a group of saints whose intercession is effective in times of illness, and has been venerated as a military saint since the Crusades.
