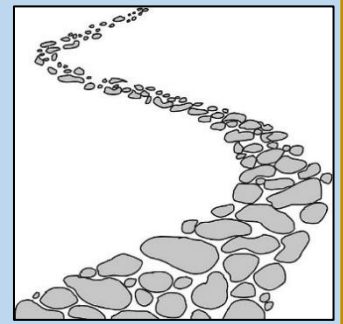

St John, who lived 347-407 AD in Antioch, was known as *Chrysostomos* (“Golden Mouth”) on account of his gift of eloquence. He was a gifted public speaker at the Golden Church of Antioch.

There he interpreted Scripture and preached compassion for the poor. He became Archbishop of Constantinople in 397, reformed the clergy and founded several hospitals. He lived a simple life but made political enemies on account of his preaching and was banished. One of his celebrated teachings is that “prayer without almsgiving is unfruitful.”
