



Theodore came from Tarsus in Turkey. A highlyeducated monk living in Rome, he was consecrated Archbishop of Canterbury at the age of 65 in 668 AD. He stayed in office until his death at the age of 87. He was very energetic travelled and across England, settling disputes, founding churches, consecrating bishops, establishing schools and summoning councils.
