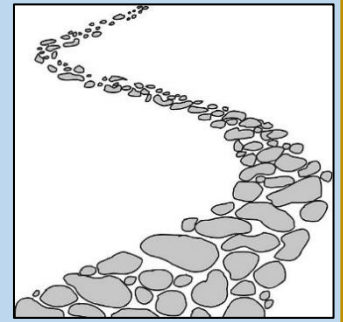
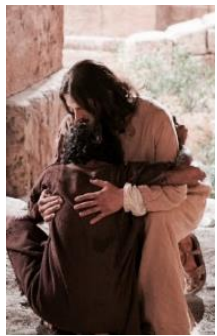

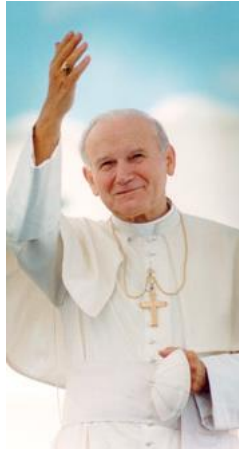

### ~ Saint Pope John Paul II ~



Pope John Paul II was born in Poland as Karol Wojtyła. He was a good sportsman and an impressive linguist. His decision to become a priest came during the war; hidden from the German forces who rounded up many of the young men in Krakow. He was made a Bishop in 1958 and in 1964 was made Archbishop of Krakow. In 1978 (the year of the three Popes) he was elected by the College of Cardinals and took the name John Paul II. He died in 2005.
