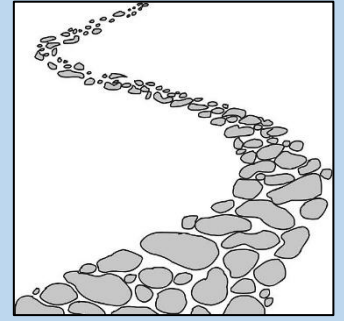

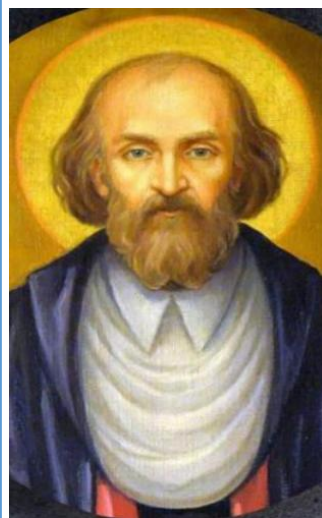
#### ROME
